

ANNEX A - About the Volunteer Management Committee

The Volunteer Management Committee (VMC) operates through three specialised sub-committees, each comprising volunteer representatives who work collaboratively with CPF Board to enhance volunteer experience and programme effectiveness.

Outreach sub-committee

Develops volunteer leadership capabilities and coordinates volunteer-led outreach initiatives

- Cultivate and grow the volunteer leader pool
- Facilitate peer-to-peer mentoring among volunteers
- Design and implement volunteer-led initiatives

Training sub-committee

Oversees the training of volunteers and regularly reviews training materials

- Co-facilitate training programmes
- Facilitate peer-to-peer knowledge sharing among volunteers
- Identify training needs and evaluate training effectiveness

Engagement sub-committee

Leads volunteer engagement efforts to foster meaningful connections within the community

- Organise regular volunteer engagement sessions to foster connections and build relationships
- Develop volunteer retention strategies
- Understand volunteer sentiments and build deeper engagement
