

## **CODE OF ETHICS**

As a volunteer of the CPF Board, I will:

- 1. Be impartial and objective in providing CPF members with information and support in their CPF matters.
- 2. Focus on helping CPF members to better understand CPF and how CPF schemes may help them. To do so, I will keep myself updated with CPF resources so as to share accurate information.
- 3. Treat CPF members with dignity and respect, and be polite and respectful in my interactions with members I encounter.
- 4. Be aware of the race, religion and culture of the CPF members and be culturally sensitive in my interactions with them.
- 5. Abide by all Singapore laws, particularly the Personal Data Protection Act, and maintain confidentiality of all data obtained while volunteering. Unless the owner of the information has given consent, I will not collect, store, disclose nor disseminate any information provided to me while volunteering.
- 6. Refrain from offering any financial or insurance products, or any other non-CPF services or products in the course of interactions with CPF members.
- 7. Decline any gifts, incentives or inducements (monetary, in-kind or otherwise) that are offered to me or others.
- 8. Refrain from making any promise, offer or contractual commitments to CPF members or any other third parties on behalf of CPF Board.
